- ✧ Ross is the Business Manager for Local 37 of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW), representing over 2200 members in New Brunswick. Since starting work for the IBEW in 1996, Ross has been heavily involved in diverse activities within the field of labour relations such as conflict resolution, negotiation, grievances and adjudication, and matters involving the NB Labour and Employment Board.
- ✧ In 2013, Ross was appointed to the IBEW International Executive Council, representing all 70,000 IBEW members across Canada on the board of the International Union. In this capacity he is also a board member of the National Electrical Benefit Fund, a large multi-employer pension plan with over \$12B USD in assets. In 2014 he was appointed as a trustee of the newly established New Brunswick Public Service Pension Plan.
- ✧ Ross lives in Saint John and has been active within his hometown where he has served on several community committees, including various work groups which focused on sustainable communities, workforce and economic development and a long-term vision for the city.
