



Public meeting - time - commencement

Regular meetings shall commence no earlier than 4:00pm and no later than 7:00 pm as determined by the Secretary and set out in the notice for the meeting.

Public meeting - notice

The Commission must give public notice of the time and place of a Commission meeting by posting notice of the meeting on Saint John Energy web site (www.sjenergy.com) the Friday before the date of the regular meeting.

Public meeting – notice – cancellation- rescheduled

The Commission must give public notice of a cancelled or rescheduled meeting or of the change of time or location by posting notice on the Saint John Energy web site (www.sjenergy.com) at least 24 hours before the date and time on which the Commission meeting was to have been held.

Audience - Commission meeting - restrictions

Members of the public who constitute the audience during a Commission meeting:

- (a) may not address the Commission without prior permission of the Commission,
- (b) shall maintain order and quiet,
- (c) shall not interrupt or interfere with the proceedings,
- (d) shall not display signs or placards

Public member - expulsion - improper conduct

Any person making personal, impertinent, or slanderous remarks or who shall become boisterous while in the meeting or addressing the Commission and refuses to apologize or withdraw his/her remarks when so directed by the Presiding Officer, or willfully obstructs the conduct of business, and refuses to desist when called upon to do so by the Presiding Officer, may be ordered by the Presiding Officer to leave the meeting, and, if he/she refuses to do so, he/she may, on the order of the Presiding Officer, be removed from that meeting.

Presentations - request on agenda - prior notice

When a member of the public or a representative of any group of persons seeks to address Commission, he/she shall submit a request, in writing to the President, addressed to the Board of Commissioners prior to 4:00 pm on the Thursday preceding the scheduled Commission meeting.

Upon considering the request to make a presentation or hear a delegation the Commission may;

- a) decline to hear the delegation/presentation or
- b) set a date, no earlier than the next regular meeting, to hear the delegation/presentation or
- c) instruct the President to schedule a mutually convenient time and date to hear the delegation/presentation

Presentations - maximum duration - limitations

Except with consent of the Commission, no member of the public shall address the Commission for more than fifteen minutes, exclusive of the time required to answer questions put to him/her by the Commission.
